I have attended the Principal Business days this week. The key work across the Palmerston and Rural region is the Continuous School Improvement framework. This will involve looking at how we are tracking across a number of areas including; professional learning, leadership and teaching and learning. This work will evolve over a 12 month period. We have a range of data we can use to stimulate discussion such as recently released Australian Educational Development Census (AEDC), NAPLAN over a number of years and perceptual data such as our student led conference survey.

We have some fantastic work happening in our classrooms. If you haven't had a chance to drop in to school recently I encourage you to pop in and check in with your child's teacher and to see the high standard of work they are producing.

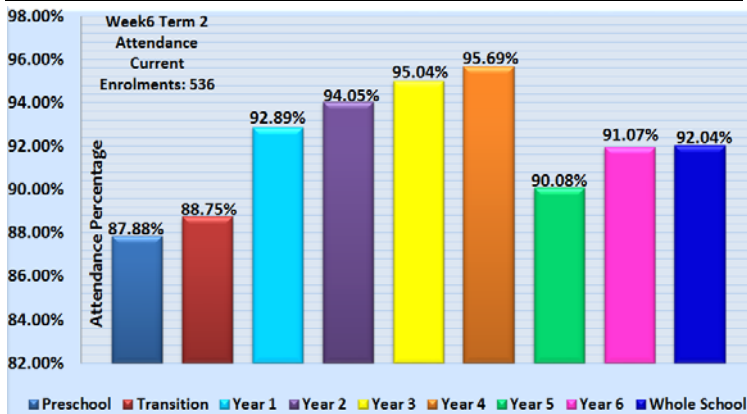
