Our Values

We proudly follow our school values of Cooperation, Confidence, and Respect. We teach children to work together, take turns, use kind words and actions, and feel proud of their efforts as they learn and grow.

Learning Through Play (EYLF)

We follow the Early Years Learning Framework (EYLF) and implement National Regulations and Guidelines to ensure our program supports children's wellbeing, learning, and development in a safe, high-quality early learning environment.

We believe children learn best when they are engaged, curious, and supported by caring adults who understand their individual needs. Our team provides a welcoming environment where children are encouraged to explore, create, communicate, take healthy risks, and develop positive friendships.

Preschool in a School Setting

As a preschool attached to a primary school, we support children to feel confident in a school environment by building early skills such as:

- following routines and expectations
- working with others and taking turns
- learning through play and hands-on experiences
- communicating needs, ideas, and feelings
- developing independence in self-help skills

Cooperative Learning (Kagan)

Rosebery is a Kagan Cooperative Learning school, and we use simple cooperative structures to help children learn with and from each other. This supports children to build communication skills, confidence, and teamwork, while also strengthening a sense of belonging in our preschool community.

Positive Behaviour (SWPBIS)

We believe positive behaviour is learned and supported through kind, consistent guidance, and as a SWPBIS school we explicitly teach and reinforce positive behaviours. We teach children how to manage emotions, solve problems respectfully, and show care for others. We celebrate effort and growth, and we work together with families to support each child.

Partnerships with Families

We recognise that families are a child's first teachers. We value respectful partnerships and open communication, and we welcome family input to help guide our planning, celebrations, and daily routines.
