ANZAC DAY Special Edition

The Rosebery Primary School community commemorated Anzac Day 2025 through multiple events and activities. On Thursday 24th of April the school held an Anzac assembly where students, families and staff gathered to pay tribute to the Australian and New Zealand soldiers who served and sacrificed for their countries. A catafalque party was present formed by 1CSSB, along with guest speaker LT Kevin Davies. Students and staff honoured the Anzacs by creating and laying a wreath under the Australian flag. Following assembly, ADF families joined us for a short morning tea. Students also had the opportunity to look through an Army vehicle which was on display as well as participate in an Anzac Hunt which was held by Mrs Sallee and multiple Defence Students. It allowed students to learn about the significance of ANZAC Day in a fun and engaging way.

This year marked 110 years since the Gallipoli Campaign, in classrooms teachers incorporated lessons, including history discussions, poetry readings, drawing and writing that reflects this event. As part of our ANZAC Day commemoration, the Year 1/2 students, led by Mrs. Sallee, worked together to create a wall art project that depicted Gallipoli, a key site in Australia and New Zealand's history. Year 3/4 Defence students worked with Mrs Sallee to write and illustrate an acrostic poem called 'Gallipoli' which was showcased at the assembly along with a reading of a book called 'The beach they called Gallipoli' by year 5/6 defence students.

On Anzac Day 2025 members of our school gathered and proudly marched together behind our school banner in the Palmerston Anzac Day March, symbolising our collective respect and remembrance for those who sacrificed their lives for our country.

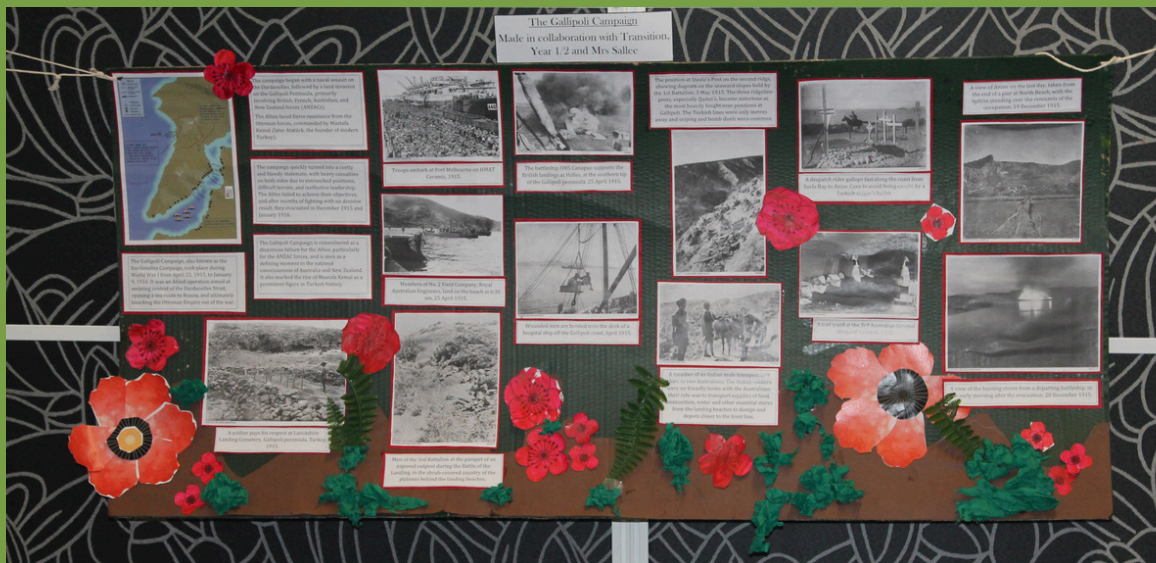

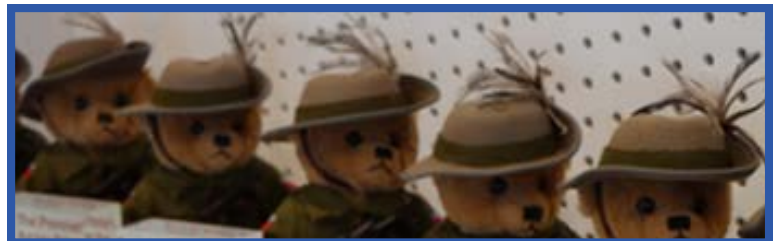
